This position works in a timely manner and strives to increase the productivity and efficacy of the inventory department.

Essential Responsibilities:

- Responsible for coordinating daily tasks.
- Required to have a working knowledge of inventory management/systems.
- Expected to coordinate the movement and storage of finished cannabis products including but not limited to concentrates, cartridges, and edibles.
- Responsible for ensuring all final packaging meets state regulatory requirements.
- Ability to stay focused for prolonged periods of time on a single task.
- Must always be monitoring and checking product/packaging for flaws, mislabeling, damages, or discoloration.
- Expected to execute periodic audits of existing inventory and report any adjustments/changes. If necessary, work with Administrative Team Lead to launch any necessary investigations.
- Expected to work well independently and not get sidetracked.
- Must always wear proper lab attire while working with products (gloves, goggles, face mask, hair net, non-slip shoes, and clean lab jackets.)
- Assist shipping and fulfillment manager in final order fulfillment steps.
- Other compliance/inventory duties as needed or as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Excellent organizational, time management, and communication skills.
- Ability to work cross-functionally with multiple departments without direct authority in a fast-paced environment.
- Strong critical thinking and problem-solving skills.
- High attention to detail.
