The Packaging Technician provides support to the Packaging Team Lead by maintaining product quality through various packaging processes. This position works in a timely manner and strives to increase the productivity of the packaging department.

Essential Responsibilities:

- Responsible for coordinating daily tasks.
- Required to work with scientific scales and must follow proper calibration requirement at the beginning of each day to ensure accuracy
- Expected to package finished cannabis products including but not limited to concentrates, cartridges, and edibles as well as all outer packaging and labeling while reducing waste.
- Ability to stay focused for long periods of time on a single task.
- Must always be monitoring and checking product for flaws, contamination, sugaring, discoloration, anything out of the ordinary.
- Expected to work well independently and not get sidetracked.
- Must always wear proper lab attire while working with products (gloves, goggles, face mask, hair net, non-slip shoes, and clean lab jackets.)
- Assist shipping and fulfillment manager in final order fulfillment steps.
- Other packaging/inventory duties as needed or as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Excellent organizational, time management, and communication skills.
- Ability to work cross-functionally with multiple departments without direct authority in a fastpaced environment.
- Strong critical thinking and problem-solving skills.
- High attention to detail.
